GRAND RIVER STEELHEAD OUTING, NOVEMBER 21ST

This is a reminder about the upcoming outing on the Grand River scheduled for Sunday, November 21st. Participants can choose between: 1) wading the Grand River in the area between Sixth Street Dam and the I-131 Bridge downstream, and 2) launching boats downstream at Johnson's Landing. From Johnson's Landing, boats can go downstream to the Buck Creek confluence or upstream as far as I-131. We will do our best to connect wading anglers who are not familiar with the Grand with someone who does know the river. There are also a few areas where participants could fish from the shore/walkways if they would prefer not wading or boating.

Participants wading the Grand or fishing from shore will meet at daylight (~7:30 am) @ the Sixth Street Fish Ladder Parking Lot on the west side of the river and disperse from there (John can give directions for anyone needing them; 517-626-6194). Boaters will meet at 7:30 am at Johnson's Landing (Denny Higelmire can give directions; 517-242-5287). If you are boating, let Denny know if you are bringing a boat or if you need to ride with someone else.

After fishing, everyone is invited to rally at 3:30 pm at Smokey Bones restaurant located on 28th Street, approximately ¼ mile south of the I-96 exit. **We encourage everyone to take pictures of their catches during the day and share stories over a slab or ribs or other dinner entrée before heading home.** Very casual clothes (even wet ones) are accepted at Smokey Bones! There will not be a weigh-in or any tournament contest. Just fun fishing!

Notification no later than November 15th is requested so that all arrangements/communications can be made.
