

2011 SW MICHIGAN STEELHEADERS SUMMER CHALLENGE LOCAL MARINA INFORMATION

The following marinas are available for docking your boat during the Summer Challenge.

1. West Basin Marina (269-983-5432) – The City of St. Joseph will provide a slip at no charge for participants in the Summer Challenge for a limit of four nights. If you wish to stay longer, the cost is \$10 per night. Slips will be available from May 2 to May 10 on a first-come-first-serve basis. No reservations will be taken and all boats must check-in at the marina office upon arrival. There are approximately 50 slips available. Fuel dock, showers, and a fish cleaning station are available. Vehicle transportation is necessary to get to the tournament site at Pier 33.

NOTE: Parking at West Basin is available in designated parking spots at the marina. This year, overflow parking will also be made available at no charge by the City in the adjacent Tiscornia Beach parking lot which is a short walk to the marina area. No parking is allowed in the grass, in driveways or private drives of local residents, in posted no parking areas, or in the St. Joseph River Yacht Club parking lot. Violators will be ticketed.

2. Pier 33 (800-886-0493) – Call for slip rates and availability. The Captain's meeting and weigh-ins will be held at Pier 33. Fuel dock, showers, and a fish cleaning station are available.
3. Harbor Isle (269-982-0812) - Call for slip rates and availability. Fuel dock, showers, and a fish cleaning station are available. Harbor Isle is within walking distance to the tournament site at Pier 33.
4. Brian's Marina (269-983-0760) – Call for slip rates and availability. Fuel dock, showers, and a fish cleaning station are available. Brian's Marina is within walking distance to the tournament site at Pier 33. A mechanic will be on call.

Note: All marinas are located upstream of the CSX train bridge except West Basin Marina. When closed, this bridge will impede larger boat traffic. Information regarding bridge activity will be available at the Captain's Meeting. The tournament schedule will not be altered for vessels caught upstream of the CSX bridge in the morning.
